ORDER OF SERVICE

CORPORATE SINGING	The service begins with a time of corporate singing during which we reflect on God’s gracious work in and for the world.

PRAYER	A time of corporate prayer in which a member brings the concerns of the community before God.
SERMON	A lesson from Christian Scripture seeking to apply its ancient wisdom to life in the modern world.
COMMUNION	A celebratory “meal” instituted by Jesus at the Last Supper consisting of bread and wine.
BENEDICTION	A concluding blessing in which members are commissioned to serve God and neighbour in the week to come.
